**TEXT: MATTHEW 6:14-24, COLOSIANS 3:23** 

## **INTRODUCTION:**

Just as we should not seek to honor and praise in this world, we should seek to store up treasure. Treasure means not only money, but all kinds of property and possessions.

To store up treasure means to keep it up for one self thus to love it.

To have possessions is not wrong, but what is wrong is to love our possessions and to use them for ourselves. 1 Timothy 6:10. It is also wrong to seek for more possessions than we need.

Jesus here means that every good work we do for God in this world will be counted or stored up as treasure in heaven. When we do good on earth, we are laying a foundation for ourselves in heaven (1 Timothy 6:17-19)

Christian investment is seen in three ways:

- 1. Giving yourself to the work of God (Rom. 12:1) Christians have to surrender to their work of God, you have to surrender your mind, your energy and your entire body to the work of God. Romans 12:1. Yu have to work hard in all that you are doing for the Lord (Colossians 3:23)
- 2. Investing spiritually by being a good steward to God's creation. Take care of what God has placed under your authority and care. Be a good manager in God's vineyard; be able to produce more for God though the talents and gifts he has given to you.
- 3. Give what you have to God's work. We do a lot of investments in various things but we are not good in investing more to the work of God.
